## **OUR SERVICES**

## ZAKAT ASSESSMENT, COLLECTION AND DISTRIBUTION

Our primary objective is to provide quality zakat assessment, collection and distribution services to both private and public individuals as well as corporate bodies. We are ever-ready to respond to any of your inquires on zakat assessment, sadaqat payment or distribution anytime of the year. Zakat assessment, sadaqat payment or distribution anytime of the year.

## **ECONOMIC EMPOWERMENT SUPPORT**

Zakat collected is used to procure merchandise goods, vocational materials, and equipment among others. This, we do in order to assist the poor to establish small-scale enterprises or repositioning of existing ones.

## **EDUCATIONAL SUPPORT**

In fulfillment of the obligation of Allah to acquire knowledge, ZSF is seriously concerned about the education of Muslim students. Therefore, we pay school fees for indigent Muslims, procure educational materials for and give research grants to both local and international students among others.

### MEDICAL SUPPORT

As a matter of priority, this is one area that touches our hearts deeply. We help those in need to off-set their bills, procure medications, treatment, undergo surgical operations within and outside the country as the situation demands.

## WIDOWS/ ORPHANS' SUPPORT

ZSF is fully committed to putting a smile in the faces of widows and orphans. This, we try to accomplish through the Sadaqat we collect from donors. During Ramadhan, Eid-ul-Fitr and Eld-ul-Adha festivals, ZSF usually provides food items, clothing materials and some monetary incentives to these people.

#### IFTAR SAIM SUPPORT

Annually, we organise Iftar Saim (i.e. feeding of fasting Muslims) across the Southwest and some parts of the South-South and northern parts of the country. We provide bags of rice, live chickens, beverages and fruits among others.

#### **MOSQUE SUPPORT**

We support the building of new mosques or renovation of existing ones. In addition, we provide utility materials to other ones as the case maybe.

#### **EMERGENCY RELIEF**

Our primary concern in this regard is to bring succour to victims of flood, fire disaster, ethno-religious and conflicts. This, we achieve by donating house-hold utensils, food items, clothing materials and funds for the rehabilitation of victims among others.

## SADAQATU JARIYAH

We encourage Muslims to revive the culture of executing projects that the less-privilege would continuously benefits from while the executor (s) too will continuously reap bountiful rewards from Allah. This can be accomplished by digging bole-holes, building schools, provisions of good motorable roads among others.

## INFAQUL AFUW (DISPOSING FAIRLY USED MATERIALS)

Many well-to-do people have abandoned materials in excess and are left unattended to; thus, they got rotten away even as their fellow men and women suffer in abject property. To assist the have and have-not in this direction, we encourage people to donate used or abandoned materials to us for onward distribution to the less-privileged ones and hence get reward from their Lord.

## WAQF

We collect donations of land, buildings or money as an endowment, which are invested, the profits from which are given away as charity for indigents, or for construction of public utilities such as borehole, schools, hospitals etc.

## SUPPORT SERVICE TO MUSLIM ORGANIZATIONS

There are many Muslim Organisations propagating pristine Islam and in their endeavours, they encounter a number of challenges impeding their growth and development. To complement their efforts, we provide office needs, furniture, propagation instruments, food items for camping programmes, sponsorship of seminars/workshops among others.

## **DETERMINING AND SHARING INHERITANCE**

**ZSF** assists in the administration of deceased estates and in most cases, we offer professional advice on inheritance that is Shariah compliant based on request.







## BRIEF BY THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR/CEO



indly permit me to join my Chairman in welcoming you to the 14<sup>th</sup> edition of Lagos State Zakat Distribution Ceremony (ZDC) courtesy of the Zakat and Sadaqat Foundation, The foremost Foundation that is committed to improve the welfare of the less privileged and add value to the Stakeholder's support.

Zakat Distribution Ceremony (ZDC) has been an annual event for the past 14 years in Lagos state where Zakat collected during the year is being distributed to the rightful Beneficiaries in the state, in furtherance to our collaborative effort with the government to improve the living condition, especially the most vulnerable and less-privileged members of our Society. Permit me to inform you that, today's event is the concluding part of our public presentations of 2018 Zakat distribution to Beneficiaries across the country which commenced in February this year. It may interest you to know that we have distributed zakat across seventeen (17) states including the Federal Capital Territory (FCT) Abuja compared to ten(10) states covered last year, 2017. The additional States covered during this year's ZDCs included Abia, Adamawa, Akwa Ibom, Eboyin, Enugu, Kaduna and Rivers.

Our distinguished Guests, We were deeply touched to see the numbers of Nigerians who were wallowing in abject poverty, which has been one of the propelling force driving us to step up Zakat collections on yearly basis despite the economic situation of our country. You would recall that about this time last year, in this same hall, the sum of N108,276,905 was disbursed to 494 beneficiaries out of the sum of N191,104,352 Zakat mobilized for the year 2017.

Today, with the support of our Zakat payers, the ever ready members of the Advisory Board, the indefatigable Board of Trustees, our valuable Subscribers and entire Stakeholders of the Foundation, we are very pleased to inform you that the sum of N142,938,905 is being distributed to 1,516 beneficiaries in Lagos state out of the total sum of N318,152,130 Zakat mobilized for this year, 2018 as at 31st October. Alhamudullilah, the above figure shows a remarkable growth of about forty percent over that of last year collections and disbursements. However we still have a long way to go as many are still lacking in basic necessities of life such as food, clothing and shelter. Year in year out the number of applicants continue to grow beyond our imagination which places more burden on us, we therefore appeal to you passionately, to help us by channeling your Zakat and other charities through our Foundation to restore hopes, creating jobs and thereby contributing our own quota to building an egalitarian Society.

This year, a sum of N72,028,520 goes for economic empowerment, N48,096,623 for health related issues, N8,494,819 allocated for educational support while the sum of N3,999,850 was used for welfare support in Lagos State.

This year general distribution commenced from February as mentioned above with the sum of twenty seven million naira (N27 Million) disbursed to patients with crucial medical needs, such as hole in the hearts, eye problems, cancer, hip joint replacement, skin grafting, spinal cord injuries, hearing problems etc., some of these patients have to be flown abroad for their treatment due to inadequate health equipment and the needed Personnel to cater for these Patients. Alhamdulillah, many of these patients had undergone successful operations and back to the country.

As at October this year, a sum of N50,856,623 had been disbursed to Beneficiaries with health related problems. This continuous growth in medical requests had made us to set up special endowment Fund on health issues tagged Health Support Fund (HSF). We therefore, passionately appeal to you to



be a Donor to this fund so that together we can build a healthy Nation. May I equally use this medium to appeal to our Government to equip our hospitals with adequate and latest equipment to reduce the need for flying our patients abroad for medical attention.

In line with our philosophy of poverty eradication through effective utilization of zakat fund, the sum of N96,514,219 was disbursed to empower Beneficiaries across the country. The empowerment given involved training of Beneficiaries in the areas of their endeavour, provision of equipments and startup capital that ranges between N30,000 to 1 million naira. It is gratifying to know that with this effort, over 1000 people had been supported directly from this year Zakat. Some of the equipment disbursed this year included Tricycles, Deep Freezers, Sewing Machines, Grass cutting Machines, Grinding Machines, Laptops and Printers etc., In the area of educational support, a sum of N13,297,019 was disbursed to assist students. The support given included payment of tuition fees, accommodation rent, purchase of books among others.

Our Community Development Project was boosted with ten (10) boreholes sunk in different communities across six (6) states in the country to provide free access to water where it is critically needed. Each borehole was provided with Generating machine to ensure constant water supply. The joy of these communities members know no bound as the Foundation was able to solve one of their major challenges which was access to portable water.

Our Senior Citizen Support programme was also well appreciated with more people benefitting. The support given included distribution of household utensils such as clothing materials, shoes, furniture, electrical appliances and cash. The number of Widows and Orphans benefiting from zakat is also on the increase. We are able to keep many students in schools due to continuous assistance given to them.

Our distinguished Guests, kindly join me in praying for all the Zakat payers that ALLAH will continue to bless them and protect them from all calamities. It is equally important to join me to appeal to all the Beneficiaries that Zakat money and equipment are a form of trust and it should be used judiciously and purposefully. Our monitoring team will visit you from time to time to ensure effective and efficient use of the fund and equipment allocated to you. Kindly cooperate with them.

Our sincere appreciation goes to the Chairman of today's occasion in person of Professor AbdurRaman Bello, the immediate past Vice Chancellor of the University of Lagos, all the Zakat and awaaf operators present here today, all our invited Guests and the Gentlemen of the Press. Kindly accept our sincere appreciation for all your contributions to the success of this year Zakat Distribution Ceremony.







## ZAKAT & SADAQAT FOUNDATION SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES.

The following are the significant accounting policies adopted by the Executives in the preparation of its financial statements:

## 1. Accounting Convention:

The financial statements are prepaid under the historical cost convention and comply with all relevant statements of accounting standards as issued to date by the Nigerian Accounting Standards Board (NASB).

## 2. Income Recognition:

- (a) Incomes stated are accounted for on cash basis, therefore incomes outstanding are not accrued for until received.
- (b) Donations and other income are recognized on cash basis. These are deferred if such income is received in advance.

## 3. Property, Plant & Equipment:

Property, Plant & Equipment are stated at cost less accumulated depreciation.

## 4. Depreciation:

Depreciation charges on fixed assets are calculated to write off the cost over the estimated useful life on a straight -line basis at the following rates:

Equipment	20%
Computer	20%
Motor Vehicle	20%
Furniture & Fittings	20%

## 5. Receivables

Receivables are stated after provisions for bad debts.






